Project 1 - Making hand made paper books (6 weeks course)

Over 6 one hour sessions, we will make paper from natural resources and recycled paper pulp learning how to make different thickness, colours and textures. The Young Crafters and Makers will learn the skills and history of hand made paper and how it is used today.

Using the paper we have made, we'll make unique books learning book binding techniques. On the front cover of the books, the young Crafters and Makers will have a go at using a pre-made screen print, which will lead onto the next 6 week project where we will be looking at how screen printing works and how to make our own designs and images using screen printing.

Each half term we will explore in detail a craft, using equipment in the Crafters and Makers resource library.
