Sew a Row Quilt - Tutor Wendy Deverill

Requirements

It is difficult to give exact quantities for a quilt of this type, as the choices of which fabric to use are made as the quilt grows.

The quantities given are generous, but will give you the opportunity to learn about 'auditioning' fabrics.

Choose Quilting cottons - 100% cotton if possible

The finished quilt top will measure 66" x 52"

In the initial course We will make the complete quilt top. For session 1, You will need to bring with you all of the background and co-ordinating fabrics. The fabric for sashing and borders can be brought along at the same time or ready for session 6

Fabric Requirements...

Background Fabric 1 ½ metres (I used an off-white fabric)

Assorted co-ordinating fabrics to make approximately 2 metres. Try to get a variety of light, medium and dark fabrics. (I used 5 different fabrics for my quilt, but you can use more)

Sashing and Borders 1 ½ metres (to be used in week 6 of the course)

Other...

We have cutting mats, rotary cutters and rulers in the studio but you are welcome to bring your own if you prefer.

Basic sewing kit: If you wish to bring your own pins, small scissors, thread that co-ordinates with your fabrics, a fabric marker, etc. Please do. We have plenty of these supplies here in the studio if you need them.

Sewing machines, irons and ironing boards are already in the studio so you won't need to bring them.

After this initial course, to complete the quilt you will need.....

Binding ½ metre

Wadding 70" x 56"

Backing Fabric 3 metres if 42" wide, 1 ¾ metres if over 60" wide
